The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the Asian Airgun Championship is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The Asian Airgun Championship will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and General Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

Jury Members (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation (ASC) to supervise the Asian Airgun Championship. The Qualified Range Officers holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

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Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to the athletes as scheduled in the Program of the competition.

4-5. Team competitions will be held if at least the team comprises are as follows:

Men and Women Senior	3 Teams for each event
Men and Women Junior	3 Teams for each event
Men and Women Youth	3 Teams for each event

Juniors may participate in one (1) category only - either in the junior's or in the senior's events.

Youth may participate in Youth Category only and Entry process of Youth participants must submit directly to OC.

5. Participation

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must register officially from his federation.

Individual Events

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for the Ranking Points according to the ISSF and ASC General Regulation.

Juniors:

In the Asian Airgun Championships, Juniors each nation can enter a maximum of six (6) in individual events. Two (2) of those athletes must be under the age of eighteen (18) years on the day of the opening of the Championship concerned. A maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation (the three top-ranked after Qualification) may proceed to the Final.

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Mixed Team Events

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event. No mixed nation teams are allowed.

Team Events

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Airgun Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points. Entry process for Youth participants must submit directly to OC.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. The ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

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ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the Asian Airgun Championship.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

6. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ASC Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service.

All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary Entries

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Airgun Championship must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **16 SEP 2022**.

Final Entries

ASC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **9 OCT 2022**.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **5 NOV 2022**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status ("Regular" athlete ↔ "Ranking Points Only" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **6 NOV 2022** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training of the corresponding event.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **6 NOV 2022** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

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Cancellation

The canceled athlete will be charged for the full amount of Entry fees + late Entry fees (if he/she registered during the late period), which is 3 days before arrival day, and the accommodation charges that is based on the contract between the hotel and the Organizing Committee. For the accommodation charges, please **refer to “9. Accommodations” for details.**

Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between the shooting range and official hotels and doping control. The entry fees do NOT include the unofficial training made before 10 NOV 2022.

In case of no show by the Positive PCR Test with the COVID-19 infection 48 hours before arrival at Korea, the penalty for the entry fees and firearms permit concerned will be exceptionally waived, if the federation sends the proof document (Positive PCR) to the Organizing Committee immediately.

Unofficial Training Fee

The shooting ranges will be open for unofficial training with costs on **6 NOV 2022**. The reservation for unofficial training from **6 to 9 NOV 2022** should be made one (1) day before your request for the financial team in the shooting range in USD cash only or by bank transfer in advance and the fees will be **USD 20** per person per lane for two (2) hours.

Payment of Entry Fees

All payments must be made to the **Organizing Committee**, not the ISSF or ASC.

ASC Member Federations are requested to pay entry fees and firearm permit fees by bank transfer in US Dollars currency (USD) by **20 OCT 2022**.

The IBAN or BIC is not assigned to local banks in Korea. The ASC Member Federation can transfer all fees to the above account by using the Swift code, instead of IBAN or BIC.

As for bank transfer, please identify clearly which country or federation is submitting the payment and send copies of the transfer voucher to the Organizing Committee by **20 OCT 2022** in order for the OC to notify the federation of net amount received correctly.

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All bank charges must be paid by the participants. Any balance for entry fees transferred has to be effected by US Dollars Cash only at the shooting range upon arrival. No traveler's checks or credit/debit cards will be accepted.

Accreditation for final registration and payment is advisable to be made by **one (1) Representative** per ASC Member Federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to the representative to bring with him/her to the Entry Confirmation.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Asian Airgun Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ASC Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and who have a photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Championship Accreditation Office at the shooting range.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

7. Shooting Range

The Asian Airgun Championship will take place at the **Daegu International Shooting Range**.

8. Immigration and Customs Requirements

VISA

Countries who require an Entrance Visa into the Republic of Korea should contact a Korean Embassy or Consulate in or near their location to obtain the visas well in advance before the departure from the corresponding country.

No arrival Visas are available in the Republic of Korea.

ASC Member Federations who need a specific Invitation Letter to apply for a Visa, please fill in the enclosed Visa Support Form (Annex 7) and return it together with scanned copies of valid passports for all visa applicants to the Organizing Committee ASAP, but not later than **9 OCT 2022**. This form must be **typed in Word Format clearly readable on PC**. The Invitation Letter will be made in Korean version and emailed to the Korean Embassy or Consulate for the federation concerned, unless the OC receives special information. If an express postal service is requested, the service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the OC.

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Detailed information updated for the visas and formalities regarding entry into a Republic of Korea can be founded in the website of the Korean Ministry of Foreign Affairs: <https://www.mofa.go.kr>.

Korea Shooting Federation and Organizing Committee have no influence on the Korean Embassies and will provide Invitations only for the participation in the Asian Airgun Championship Daegu 2022.

Custom Formalities / Temporary Import of Firearms

ASC Member Federations must declare all firearms brought into Korea for the Asian Airgun Championship in advance. **The federation has to fill in the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) clearly and return it with the scanned copies of the valid passport of each athlete to the Organizing Committee by email as soon as possible but not later than 9 OCT 2022.**

Please make sure that the form should be reached the OC at the latest **one (1) month** before arrival to get the approval on their temporary importation into the Republic of Korea in due time if any firearm and ammunition reach prior to the Official Arrival Day.

Please type in PC ONLY (no Handwriting) on the Excel Form (do not use a PDF format) when completing the Firearms Form and send it back by email (**No Fax Transmission** will be accepted)!

The OC will support the custom clearance of firearms at the **Daegu International Airport (TAE)** which is main official airport and, if requested, the **Seoul-Incheon International Airport (ICN)** additionally. There will be **NO ASSISTANCE** at customs and immigration for participants arriving at other airports.

For the delegation fly to and from the **Daegu Airport (TAE)** directly, the OC will exceptionally cover firearm permit without charge. However, providing the delegation reach with firearms at the **Seoul-Incheon Airport (ICN)** first, the firearm customs must be made at **ICN** and the firearm permit will be charged at **USD 25.00** per air gun accordingly. This has to be wired to the OC bank account at the latest **20 OCT 2022**.

All athletes must go directly to the custom after baggage claim at arrival at **TAE or ICN** to verify that the serial numbers of their own firearms are identical with the ones declared in advance.

Please note that any firearm that was not declared in advance on the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) or was not correctly declared, can not be released and will be kept in the custody of customs on arrival. All firearms and ammunition have to be handed over to the OC staffs just after custom clearance at TAE or ICN.

The police and OC staff will deliver all air guns and air pellets from **TAE / ICN** to the armory of shooting range in Daegu, separating from delegation. This procedure will be applied same at departure.

It is strictly prohibited by the local security code that any athlete or delegation take any firearm (including air guns and air pellets) for themselves out of the airport or to the hotel.

The team leader will be kindly requested to contact the OC at the shooting range three (3) days before the departure to get the necessary departure information.

9. Accommodations

Official Hotels

All room rates are calculated per room / per night.

These rates include breakfast, VAT and service charges.

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No payment to the ASC or the Hotel – Payment must be made directly to the Organizing Committee.

Grand Hotel (**):** Single USD 115 / Twin USD 140

Distance & Duration from shooting range 19km, 25 min / airport TAE 7km, 20 min / airport ICN 350km, 4 hr.

Hotel Inter-Burgo Exco (**):** Single USD 100 / Twin USD 125

Distance & Duration from shooting range 13km, 20 min / airport TAE 3.5km, 15 min / airport ICN 330km, 4 hr.

Convention Hotel (*):** Single USD 85 / Twin USD 105 *Limited twin room and offered minor breakfast*

Distance & Duration from shooting range 13km, 20 min / airport TAE 3.5km, 15 min / airport ICN 330km, 4 hr.

Preliminary Hotel Reservation has to be effected by **16 SEP 2022**.

Final Hotel Reservation has to be effected by **9 OCT 2022**.

Late check-out: Official check-out time at official hotels is by 11:00 AM. 50% of the daily accommodation costs will be charged in case of check out from 11:00 AM to 3 PM, and a full daily charge after 3 PM on the basis of room type occupied.

Hotel reservation must be made through the Organizing Committee. The reservation can be only considered on a first come-first served basis once the OC receives the duly filled Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 5), not the Preliminary Hotel Form. Then the OC will inform the federation of the hotel name. On request, the Proforma Invoice for local accommodation will be sent. All participating federations are requested to wire **a minimum of 80% of the total accommodating costs to the OC account by 15 OCT 2022**. Please remind that OC may not guarantee the accommodation if a minimum of 80% of total accommodating costs is not paid by the deadline.

The Organizing Committee kindly ask ASC Member Federations to provide a second and third choice hotel in case of full occupation of the first choice to perform the optimal booking and avoid accommodating the members of the same team in different hotels.

Any change about local accommodation including room type etc. during their stay in official hotels must be made through the Organizing Committee at the Championship. All extra charges such as telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals and laundry etc. that occur at the official hotels must be paid directly to the hotel at check-out.

The deadline for any change or cancellation of a hotel reservation is 18 OCT 2022, 24:00h in Korean local time. In case of cancellation or no-show after this date, the penalty fee will be equal to **100%** of the total cost for any cancelled reservation or room that was not occupied.

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However, exceptionally, in case of Positive PCR 48 hours before arrival at Korea, no show penalty of accommodation for **two (2) nights** per room booked will be charged, if the federation concerned sends the proof document (Positive PCR) to the Organizing Committee immediately.

Food Service at the Shooting Range

Light meals, snacks and drinks will be available at the shooting range at the reasonable prices.

10. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival & Departure

The main official airport for pickup is the **Daegu International Airport (TAE)**. And **Seoul-Incheon International Airport (ICN)** will be also available additionally on request in advance. There will be **NO ASSISTANCE** at customs and immigration for participants arriving at other airports.

Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

ASC Member Federations are recommended to directly fly to and from **TAE** which it takes 20 min to the official hotels. **TAE** opens international airlines to and from Bangkok (THA), Fukuoka (JPN) every day and other city. Free airport pickup service is available between **TAE** and the official hotels from **8 to 19 NOV 2022**.

ASC Member Federations are requested to contact the OC as soon as possible but not later than **9 OCT 2022** to arrange transportation accordingly.

From **ICN** to Daegu, it takes about 4 hours by vehicle. The vehicle will be available at the cost of **USD 600.00** for minivan (Max 5 pax), **USD 700.00** for minivan (Max 8 pax) and **USD 1,000.00** for large bus (Max. 25 pax) each **ONE WAY**, if requested by the federation in advance but not later than **9 SEP 2022**. The max. number of people which can accommodate at the vehicle may be subject to change by the number of luggage.

The delegation will be transported directly to the official hotels from **TAE / ICN**, not via the shooting range. All firearms will be separately transported from both airports to the armory of shooting range in Daegu by police and OC staff. The same procedure will be made at departure.

Details about the meeting point or information desk at both airports will be announced later.

Delegations that arrive earlier than **8 NOV 2022** or leave later than the Official Departure Day (**19 NOV 2022**) must make their arrangements for transportation with the Organizing Committee. If requested by the federation in advance but not later than **9 SEP 2022**, the OC will arrange airport pick-up service at the unofficial days at a reasonable cost. The transportation between **TAE** and the official hotels will be available at the cost of **USD 150.00** for minivan (Max 5 pax), **USD 200.00** for minivan (Max 8 pax) and **USD 300.00** for large bus (Max. 25 pax) each **ONE WAY**.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

For delegation that accommodate at official hotels through the Organizing Committee, free shuttle service will be provided between the hotels and the shooting range from **10 to 18 NOV 2022 ONLY**. **No shuttle service to and from the shooting range on the Official Arrival Day (9 NOV 2022)**.

The shuttle schedule will be available at the information bulletin at the hotels and the OC website (<http://aac2022.shooting.or.kr>).

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Any delegation accommodating at non-official hotel must make all their local transportation (airport-hotel-shooting range) by themselves **regardless of the payment of entry fees**. This will apply same for any delegation who directly book the official hotels by themselves, not through the OC.

11. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place at **13:00h. on 10 NOV 2022** at the **Finals Hall at the shooting range**.

Each participating ASC Member Federation is requested to make at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, competition procedures and other important issues at the Asian Airgun Championship. The time of meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

During stays in Daegu-Korea for the Asian Airgun Championship, all air guns and air pellets must be deposited in the armory at the shooting range.

It is strictly prohibited to take any air guns and air pellets out of the shooting range premises.

Every day the armory staff and police will check at 19:00h to confirm that all guns and ammunitions are returned to the armory after training / competition. Participants who wish to arrive earlier than **6 NOV 2022** or leave later than **19 NOV 2022** must pay an additional cost to use the armory, which is **USD 100.00 per federation**. This cost must be paid to the OC with entry fees in cash or bank transfer.

Ammunitions

There is no limitation on the quantity of air pellets which participants can bring into the Republic of Korea for the purpose of training and competition during the Asian Airgun Championship.

Delegations are requested to bring all necessary air pellets to be used in training and competition. Please make sure that Korean custom regards air pellets as normal ammunitions. Accordingly, the amounts of air pellets brought into Korea must be also declared to the OC within the deadline (**9 OCT 2022**).

Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Control Tests according to the WADA/ ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ASC Test Distribution Plan under the supervision of the ASC Technical Delegate.

12. Temporary Regulations for Testing and Health Monitoring Methods for Covid-19

The Organizing Committee will do everything to minimize the risks of Covid-19 infections and follow the instruction of Korean government and ASC.

For participating delegations:

1. All passengers must take a PCR Test in 48 hours before arrival to the Rep. of Korea in their country regardless of vaccination certificate. Register the necessary information and Negative PCR on Q-code system website (<https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr>) before arrival at Korea to simplify the immigration procedure.

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All delegation must take another PCR Test in 24 hours on arrival at Korea. **The testing cost upon arrival at Korea will be exceptionally covered by the Organizing Committee at the Asian Airgun Championship.** please stay at the hotel until a Negative PCR informed and upload the arrival PCR result on Q-code system.

2. The PCR Test for departure from Korea is NOT required by Korean government. It is the responsibility of the delegation in accordance with requirement of each country and airline. The Organizing Committee will help and support it on request accordingly.

PCR Testing Cost at hospital in Daegu: USD 75.00 per person

3. Masks must be worn permanently while stay indoors.
4. Physical distancing guidelines must be followed at all times during their stays in Daegu and Korea.
5. Upon display of any symptoms, cough or fever, members must seek medical attention ASAP then, in case of a Positive PCR, self-quarantine for seven (7) days at the designated hotels at his/her own cost for test and accommodation until obtaining a Negative PCR.

The above mentioned is effect as of July 2022 and depends on the progress of Covid-19 infections. The PCR testing cost is also subject to change later. The OC will announce all ASC Member Federations of any update of the Temporary Regulation on Covid-19 in due time before the Championship.

Important! It may take one day to get the result since PCR tested. All participants must stay at the hotel until the result reached. Accordingly, please pay attention that it may be dangerous for delegation to reach Korea just one day before the Pre-Event Training and/or the competition. Depending on the arrival, you need to arrive at two (2) days before the day you wish to be on the shooting range.

13. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

Opening Ceremony will take place on **10 NOV 2022** in accordance with a guidance of COVID-19 Rules and Regulations by local government. The time and place will be noticed at a later stage.

No Closing Ceremony will not be held.

Victory Ceremony

Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after each Final (see also: Final Competition Schedule at the later stage).

During the ceremonies, the athletes who receive awards are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

National Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations. OC will arrange them in advance and verify them through the Team representative at the shooting range.

14. Weather Information

During the Championship, the weather in Daegu is pleasant and cool. The temperature is expected to be 9°C – 17°C during the day and 4°C – 9°C during the night.

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15. Media Relations

All Media representatives must register for the Asian Airgun Championship by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).

A Media office will be available at the shooting range during the Asian Airgun Championship, equipped with internet, telephone and fax connection. No press conferences are planned.

Finals will be covered by local TV and will be displayed on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

16. Industry Service

The Organizing Committee will provide industry services and displays or exhibitions wishing to make them at the shooting range. The industry or company wishing to use a booth at their own costs for the purposes of exhibition or product sales are required to contact the OC directly for further details and costs.
